

Camp Dawson Fast Facts

Where & When:

- * **Camp Dawson: June 3-7, 2019**
- * Thomasville History Center address: 725 N. Dawson St. (Telephone: 226-7664)
- * *Camp begins at 9:00 a.m. and ends at 4 p.m.* each day. **Drop off begins at 8:45 am.** For drop-off and pick-up, we ask that you enter the History Center driveway and look for our “traffic director.”
- * Friday, June 7th, we invite the campers’ family and friends to the History Center at 3:30p.m. for a *special program!*

What to Wear:

- * Plan to get messy! Wear cool, comfortable clothing that can get dirty or stained.
- * Your child must wear *closed-toe shoes!*
- * Please apply insect repellent and sunscreen prior to camp. We will have plenty on hand for the rest of the day so you do not need to send it along with your camper unless they have an allergy or require specific brands, etc.
- * On Friday, we ask that all campers wear their *Camp Dawson* T-shirts.

What to Bring:

- * Please provide a lunch each day labeled with your camper’s name.
- * Lunches can be refrigerated, but space is limited and the microwave will not be available for campers’ use. Pack accordingly!
- * Snacks and beverages will be provided by the History Center each day.
- * Water is available at all times, and campers are encouraged to bring a *refillable bottle* to carry with them throughout the day. Please label the water bottle with your child’s name. *Please remind your child to drink water frequently!*

What Not to Bring:

- * Personal games, cell phones, toys, beauty products, electronics, cameras, or other such items at home.
- * Cameras are allowed on Friday for the special program, but keep in mind, camp photos will be available online a week to two weeks after camp has ended.

Allergies, Medications, & Medical Conditions:

- * Please note on the *Registration Form* if your child has any conditions that might cause concern in this environment (prone to dehydration, allergies, etc) that camp staff should know about, including *food or environmental allergies*, or whether your child is prone to dehydration.
- * Please label inhalers and medications with your child’s name and give to a member of the History Center staff the first day of camp.
- * If your child is unable to participate in camp activities for some reason, we will call the contact numbers provided and ask you to come and get your child.
