

Camp LPH Fast Facts

Where & When:

- * **June 18-20, 2019**
- * Lapham-Patterson House address: **626 N. Dawson St.** (Thomasville History Center telephone: 226-7664) or Amelia's cell: 910-520-9619
- * *Camp begins at 9:00 a.m. and ends at 4 p.m.* each day.
- * Drop off begins at 8:45 am. For drop-off and pick-up, we ask that you pull to the side of the House on Webster Street and look for Amelia. Campers will use the last door on the end before the backyard. Campers may also enter through the kitchen door in the courtyard.

What to Wear:

- * Wear cool, comfortable clothing **that can get dirty or stained.**
- * Your child must wear *closed-toe shoes!*
- * We will be spending time outdoors, so hats are allowed!
- * Please apply insect repellent and sun screen prior to camp.

What to Bring:

- * Please provide a lunch each day labeled with your camper's name.
- * Lunches can be refrigerated, no microwave access for campers. Pack accordingly!
- * Snacks and beverages will be provided by the History Center each day.
- * Water is available at all times, and campers are encouraged to bring a *refillable bottle* to carry with them throughout the day. Please remind your child to drink water frequently!

What Not to Bring:

- * Please leave: personal games, cell phones, beauty products, electronics, cameras, or other such items at home.

Allergies, Medications, & Medical Conditions:

- * Please note on the *Registration Form* if your child has any conditions which might cause concern in this environment that camp staff should know about, including *food allergies* or being prone to dehydration.
- * Please label inhalers and medications with your child's name and give to a member of the History Center staff the first day of camp.
- * If your child is unable to participate in camp activities for some reason, we will call the contact numbers provided and ask you to come and get your child.
